#### Sidewalk Vending Survey

The City of Long Beach is launching a Sidewalk Vending Survey to collect community input that will inform the development of the rules and regulations of sidewalk vending. The survey will be available online until Sunday, December 18th at <a href="www.longbeach.gov/sidewalkvending">www.longbeach.gov/sidewalkvending</a>. Printed versions will be available at all twelve Long Beach Public Libraries. Everyone that lives, works, studies, or visits Long Beach is encouraged to share their feedback on sidewalk vending. For Naples, primary potential impact areas are 2<sup>nd</sup> Street, Mother's Beach, and then the Canals/Fountain during the holidays.


#### Take the Micro-Transit Shuttle! It's Free!

LB Circuit will provide a free on-demand app-based shuttle service in two service areas: 1) Downtown-Alamitos Beach, and 2) Alamitos Bay-Belmont Shore. The micro-transit shuttles are 100% electric and can accommodate 5 passengers. Two of the shuttles will be ADA-accessible to accommodate wheelchair use and are expected to be integrated into service. ADA-accessible shuttles will be available upon request through the mobile app. Hours of operation for the shuttles will be Thursday and Fridays, 4:00 pm to 10:00 pm, Saturday, 12:00 pm – 10:00 pm, and Sunday, 12:00 pm to 6:00 pm. For free on-demand rides to and from anywhere within each service area simply download the Ride Circuit mobile app via App Store or Google Play or visit ridecircuit.com for more information. The 5-passenger shuttles are 100% electric. As part of a future phase, staff will be exploring ways to connect these two service areas to allow easy transfers if desired. More info here.



#### Traffic Impact from Lagoon Restoration Project

The Colorado Lagoon Open Channel project consists of restoring wetlands and subtidal habitat through the creation of an open earthen channel between Colorado Lagoon and Marine Stadium. Construction will begin on the Monday after Thanksgiving resulting in traffic disruption for 16 months while the two bridges are constructed. One bridge is on Colorado just east of Elliot and the other on Elliot near just east of the Marine Stadium Concert Park. To visit friends in Alamitos Heights, Spinnaker Bay, Bay Harbour, and the other communities in that area, or to get to Bellflower Blvd., you will need to access via 7<sup>th</sup> Street or Pacific Coast Highway. **More info here.** 



### Who's My Block Captain?

LB CERT – Naples Island has over 70 residents serving as Block Captains – do you know who yours is?

Block Captains share information with their neighbors regarding emergency preparedness and are trained to provide help during a disaster such as a large earthquake. This includes suppressing small fires, checking on neighbors, performing search and rescue, and administering life-saving first aid. Contact your Block Captain to find out more about the Naples Island Emergency Plan and to share information about needs your household may have, or resources/skills you may have to offer in an emergency.


Naples News magazine is building its team of volunteer contributors.
